Dry House White Wine –

Le Caprice Chenin Blanc, Vdp du Val de Loire 07/08

An unoaked wine with an 'easy drinking' style which pushes the fruit to the fore on well balanced but generally soft and supple palates.

SPARKLING WINE

South-Eastern Australia-Berri Estates Cuvee Brut.

A soft, fruity 'Aussie sparkler' with a lively effervescence. The aromatic Sultana and the crisp Colombard and Chenin Blanc grapes make a perfect combination of fruit and acidity.

South-Eastern Australia-Berri Estates Brut Rose.

A bright, light crimson 'Aussie sparkler' brimming with summer-fruit flavours. Made using a base of the aromatic Sultana and Colombard with the colour coming from the inclusion of Cabernet Sauvignon, Grenache and Shiraz in the blend.

CHAMPAGNE

Louis Dornier et Fils Brut

A light, fresh, vigorously youthful champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long, crisp palate.

RED WINES

Spain - Marques de Morano Rioja Crianza Tinto, 2005/06

Made from Tempranillo and Mazuelo grapes, which are matured for at least a year in cask followed by at least a year in bottle to give that classic smooth oaky taste.

Italy - Chianti, Ruffino 2006/07

A very flexible wine with soft, ripe fruit untouched by oak and balanced with a smooth finish.

France - Fleurie Domaine de Prion, E. Loron et Fils 2006/07

Owned by the Chanudet family since 1917, this 12-hectare property, now run by the fourth generation, has plots in different parts of this sought after village. The 35-year-old vines produce a wine of excellent concentration and depth.

France - Chateau La Fleur Plaisance, Montagne Saint Emilion 2005

A soft, ripe wine with a delicious red fruit character, from a vineyard in the Montagne Saint-Emilion region.

WHITE WINES

South Africa – Cullinan View Chenin Blanc, Robertson. 2007/08

A delicious unoaked off-dry Chenin Blanc with a fresh, zesty acidity.

Chile – Casa La Joya Estate Sauvignon Blanc, Rapel Valley 2007/08

An unoaked popular varietals with the emphasis firmly placed on the fruit flavours, a zesty Sauvignon Blanc.

France – Muscadet de sevre et Maine La Doussiniere. 2007/08

A bone-dry white wine from the Muscadet grape, grown in the Western Loire valley close to the city of Nantes. Ever popular.

South- Eastern Australia – Short Mile Bay Riesling.2005/06

A Juicy, lime and lemon scented Reisling, coming from the Padthaway region.

Australia – Berri Estates Unoaked Chardonnay.2006/07

A popular single grape varietals, which sees no oak in its production.

WHITE WINES

Italy – Pinot Grigio delle Venezia Giulia Lumina, Ruffino 2006/07

A fine example of Pinot Grigio with soft, delicate apple, pear and juicy lemon aromas which are reflected on elegant, refined, mineral palate.

Australia – Penfolds Rawsons Retreat Semillon Chardonnay 2004/06

Partially barrel-fermented and briefly oak aged with fresh citrus and green mango flavours.

France – Macon-villages, Beauvernon, Thorin. 2006/07

Fresh, Lemony style with no oak ageing to mask the fruit.

France – Petit Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils. 2006/07

From the outlying parts of the Chablis region comes this dry, steely white wine.

RED WINES

South African - Kleine Zalze Pinotage, Stellenbosch 2006/07

This wine is made to a very modern style, using this South African grape variety. A deep fruity nose and rich berry flavours with hints of prunes and without harsh tannins, which sometimes accompanies Pinotage wines.

South Eastern Australia - Hardys The Riddle Cabernet Merlot, 2007/08

This wine is made using modern cool-fermentation techniques, with an aromatic off-dry Riesling-Gewurztraminer with exotic fruit flavours.

Chile - Casa La Joya Estate Reserve Merlot, Colchagua Valley 2006/07

A superbly rich and concentrated wine.

75cl £11.25

South-Eastern Australia - Berri Estates Shiraz. 2006/07

The grapes are sourced from the Riverland and Murray-Darling regions. This wine has just enough oak to give the ripe fruit flavours a spicy dimension.

France - Cotes du Rhone Gentilhomme, A. Ogier et Fils 2005/06

Made in a traditional, robust style using a high percentage of Syrah and benefiting from oak barrel ageing.
